## Under the agreement for 2015 Walkerston State School will receive

### This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of children achieving national minimum standard in Writing from 90.6% to 95% in Year 3 and 88.4% to 92% in Year 5.
- Increase the percentage of children in U2B in Y5 from 14% to 20% in Writing, and from 14.3% to 26% in Numeracy.
- Increase the average percentage of children achieving A-C grades in English across the school from 74% to 82% in English and 79% to 85% in Numeracy.

### Our strategy will be to

- Provide professional development and coaching to ensure teachers are able to deconstruct and adapt the Australian Curriculum.
- Build teacher capability in gathering and using evidence to more accurately differentiate teaching to meet the needs of groups of children and individuals.
- Establish a professional learning community of school professionals to implement, evaluate and disseminate strategies throughout the school.
