## This funding will be used to


- Produce a pedagogical framework which outlines an agreed primary pedagogical approach in consultation with our Local Consultative Committee.
- Increase the percentage of children achieving A in English and Maths to CQ average distributions.
- Evidence consistent use of Australian Curriculum V8.3 in Pupil Progress Meetings and lesson observations.
- Implement an agreed approach to enhance ICT provision for children by the end of 2017.

## Our initiatives include

- Teachers will engage in collaborative work through Professional Learning Communities to improve alignment of identified next steps for higher-achieving children, evidence of learning and the Australian Curriculum.
- Staff to undertake professional development in using ICT for learning to determine the best approach to enhancing ICT provision for children.
- Collaborate with staff to explore research-based pedagogical approaches which will help us meet our core teaching and learning objectives.

1. Employment of Teacher Aides to support implementation of a consistent pedagogical approach across the school.	\$88,717
2. Release for Teachers to participate in Pupil Progress Meetings.	\$9,839
3. Professional development for teachers to determine our infrastructure model for delivery of the Digital Technologies curriculum.	\$6,300
